MARIAH HAT

KNITTING PATTERN





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Skill level: intermediate

Sizes: 0-3m/6m/1y

To fit head:

14" (36 cm)/17"(43)/18"(46)

MATERIALS

DK weight yarn (no 3; 8 ply; 11 wpi) in two colors such as Katia Bamboo and Katia Degradé Sun 40g or 100 yards total

Double pointed knitting needles US 4 (3.5 mm) or to obtain gauge 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm) = 20 sts x 28 rows (in stockinette stitch)

Bead for decorating

ABBREVIATIONS

St(s) – stitches

RS and WS – right and wrong side

MC and CC – main and contrast color yarn

K – knit

P –purl

SI – slip

Kfb – knit in front and back of stitch

K2tog – knit two stitches together

P2tog – purl two stitches together

Ssk – slip slip knit

Passo – pass slipped stitch over

PATTERN NOTES

Before you start, check your gauge

The hat is worked in the round

THE HAT

With CC yarn cast on 60/72/78 sts (choose depending on the size 0-3m/6m/1y and follow the given number throughout the pattern), join working in the round making sure there is no twist.

Round 1: purl all stitches

Rounds 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6: *k1, p1* all around

Round 7: purl all stitches

Switch to MC yarn and continue in stockinette stitch until the hat measures about $4 \frac{1}{2}$ /5 $\frac{1}{2}$ /6" (that is 12/14/15 cm).

Decrease:

Round 1: *ssk, k4* all around (50/60/65 stitches left)

Rounds 2, 4 and 6: knit all stitches

Round 3: *ssk, k3* all around (40/48/52 stitches left)

Round 5: *ssk, k2 all around (30/36/39 stitches left)

Round 7: *ssk, k1* all around s (20/24/26 stitches left)

Rounds 8: *ssk* all around (10/12/13 stitches left)

Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining stitches, fasten. Weave in all ends.

THE FLOWER

With CC yarn cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: k1, kfb, k1 (4 stitches total)

Row 2: purl all stitches

Row 3: sl1, kfb, kfb, k1 (6)

Row 4: purl all stitches

Row 5: sl1, kfb, k2, kfb, k1 (8)

Row 6: purl all stitches

Row 7: knit all stitches

Row 8: purl all stitches

Row 9: sl1, ssk, k till end (7)

Row 10: sl1, p2tog, p till end (6)

Row 11: sl1, ssk, k till end (5)

Row 12: sl1, p2tog, p till end (sl1, p2tog, p till end (4)

Row 13: sl1, ssk, k1 (3)

Row 14: sl1, p2tog, passo (1). Turn.

With right side facing cast on 2 stitches, continue with petal 2:

Purl all three stitches on WS and now again with right side facing work:

Row 1: k1, kfb, k1 (4 stitches total)

Row 2: purl all stitches

Row 3: sl1, kfb, kfb, k1 (6)

Row 4: purl all stitches

Row 5: sl1, kfb, k2, kfb, k1 (8)

Row 6: purl all stitches

Row 7: knit all stitches

Row 8: purl all stitches

Row 9: sl1, ssk, k till end (7)

Row 10: sl1, p2tog, p till end (6)

Row 11: sl1, ssk, k till end (5)

Row 12: sl1, p2tog, p till end (4)

Row 13: sl1, ssk, k1 (3)

Row 14: sl1, p2tog, passo (1).

Cut the yarn.

Make 3 double petals. Place all three to the hat crossing each other and sew them on the hat, decorate the flower with a bead.



After finishing first petal, cast on two stitches with right side facing.
