## TERESA HEADBAND

## CROCHET PATTERN



THIS IS A FREE PATTERN

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Skill level: easy

## Sizes: newborn/6m/1y/3y/child/woman

To fit head
$14^{\prime \prime}(36 \mathrm{~cm}) / 17(43) / 18(46) / 19(48) / 20(51) / 22(56)$

## MATERIALS

Fingering (14 wpi; 4 ply; no 1: Super Fine) yarn such as Alize Bella in two colors about 20 g or 80 yards total

Crochet hook US C/2 ( 2.5 mm ) or to obtain gauge $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) = 24 sts $\times 26$ rows (in single crochet) gauge not that important

Bead for decorating

## PATTERN NOTES

All crochet terms are US
Use smaller hook to get the stiffness
The negative ease of the headband is about an inch (3 cm ), if you want it more fitted, work another inch less than indicated
ABBREVIATIONS
St(s) - stitch(es)
SI - slip
Ch - chain
Sc - single crochet
Dc - double crochet
Hdc - half double crochet

## THE BAND

The band is worked flat. With main yarn (white) ch 4 for all sizes.

Row 1: (3 dc, ch 1, 2 dc ) all into 4th ch from the hook, turn

Row 2: Ch 3, sc in first dc, (3 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) all into ch space, turn

Repeat Row 2 until the band measures $13 / 16 / 17 / 18 / 19 / 21$ " (that is $33 / 41 / 43 / 46 / 48 / 53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for newborn/6m/1y/3y/child/ woman sizes.

Now join both ends: ch 1, work 1 sc in each of the 4 foundation ch and last 4 stitches of the last row.

Cut the yarn, fasten off.

## THE FLOWER

The flower is worked flat. With contrast color (pink) ch 32.

Row 1: Sc into $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, (ch 4, skip 2 ch, sc into next ch) 6 times, (ch 3, skip 1 ch, sc into next ch) 6 times, turn (You have 12 ch spaces)

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, ch $2,4 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each next 6 ch space, ( $s c$, ch $3,6 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 3 , sc) in each next 6 ch space, turn

Change to main color yarn.
Row 3: *Sl st in sc, ch 6, (sl st, 1 hdc, ch 3, 1 hdc, sl st) all between $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{dc}$, ch 6 , $s$ st in next $s c^{*}$ repeat from
*_* for all the first 6 larger petals, *sl st in sc, ch 4, (sl st, 1 hdc , ch $3,1 \mathrm{hdc}$, sl st) all between $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{dc}$, ch 4 , sl st in next sc *, repeat from *-* for all the last 6 smaller petals.

Fasten off with a long tail. Roll the flower together starting with smaller petals, fasten with few stitches and sew to the headband, decorate with a bead.
