ZANE COWL

KNITTING PATTERN

Skill level: easy

Sizes: kids/adult

Cowl length 8" (20 cm)/14(35)

MATERIALS

Aran (8 wpi; 10 ply; no 4: Medium) yarn such as Schachenmayr Journey 50g or 95 yards

Knitting needles US 10 (6 mm) or to obtain gauge 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm) = 20 stitches x 22 rows (stockinette stitch)

Tapestry needle, 1 big button

PATTERN NOTES

Before you start, check your gauge, adjust needles to get the right gauge

Cowl is knitted flat and seamed from one side

THE COWL

Cast on 90/100 (kids/adult and follow the given number throughout the pattern) stitches and continue:

Row 1 (right side): *knit 1, purl 1*, repeat from *-* all across

Row 2 (wrong side): Work each stitch as it faces to you that is knit the knit and purl the purl stitches

Repeat Rows 1-2 until the piece measures about 6.5/12.5" (that is 17/32 cm).

Next right side row make the buttonhole.

Buttonhole row: (knit 1, purl 1) x repeat 3 times, bind off next 2 stitches, *knit 1, purl 1*, repeat from *-* all across

Next wrong side row cast on 2 new stitches over the bind off stitches.

Repeat Rows 1-2, 3 times more and bind off all stitches.

Seam the cowl together halfway leaving the rest open, fold this part on top.

Attach the button to the inner layer of the cowl behind the buttonhole, about 1"-1.5" (that is 2.5-4 cm) from the bottom edge.

Weave in all ends.
